WHAT: All-over sheer

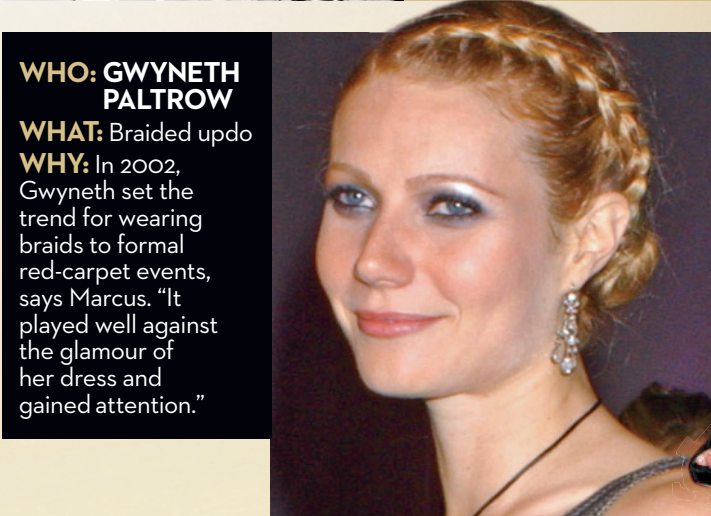
